Easter Raffle

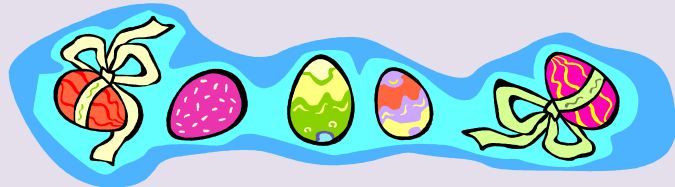

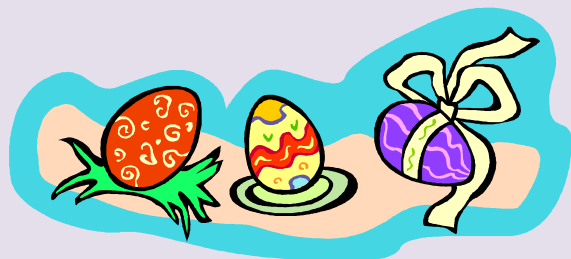
Tickets will be 50c each or 3 for \$1.
